BRIGADIER GENERAL BENNET S. SACOLICK

Deputy Commanding General

Brigadier General Bennet S. Sacolick is the Deputy Commanding General of the John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center and School based at Fort Bragg, N.C.

BG Sacolick enlisted in the United States Army in 1981 and was assigned to 2nd Ranger Battalion prior to attending Officer Candidate School. He was commissioned as an Infantry Officer in June 1982. His military education is consistent with that of a career Special Forces officer and includes a Master's Degree from Central Michigan University and Army Fellowship to the Central Intelligence Agency.



BG Sacolick has commanded Special Operations Forces at the detachment, troop, squadron and group level. He has had various staff assignments to include Chief of Current Operations at the Joint Special Operations Command and the Deputy Director for Defense at the CIA's Counter Terrorism Center. He has completed tours with 1st Battalion, 509th Airborne Battalion Combat Team in Vicenza, Italy; 3rd Battalion, 7th Special Forces Group (Airborne) in Panama; Military Advisor in El Salvador; and more than 12 years in 1st Special Forces Operational Detachment – Delta, culminating as both the unit and Task Force Commander during Operation IRAQI FREEDOM.

BG Sacolick has participated in combat operations in El Salvador, Peru, Colombia, Bosnia, and Operations JUST CAUSE, DESERT STORM, RESTORE HOPE, ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM.

Brigadier General Sacolick is married to the former Joyce Creech.
